Flight Nanny Options:

I now have two flight nanny companies from which you can choose. I will explain both of them, how they work, and pricing. I will also need to know if there is a day you cannot pick up your kitten at the airport. This date will be set after kitten pick-up days. I have to be here for when kittens are being picked up and I would not be available to drive to the airport until after these dates. The first one I list I prefer as I know them personally.

Jeff and Daphne Brooks - Mountain Peak Maine Coons

- Pay the flights, kitten fee, and \$400 cash at delivery plus tip. I'm not sure of the whole amount, until I let them know which airport they will be flying to. I do know it's more than Pet Jet Pals.
- This flight will be booked with a set day and time. No standby.

PET JET PALS

The flight nanny flies standby, so you need to be flexible on the pick-up dates/times because occasionally the first or second delivery date needs adjusted if there are no open standby seats to IND Airport. Most deliveries within the United States for one kitten are \$500-650 USD. \$750 for 2 kittens.

*Alaska and Puerto Rico \$750-850 USD. Some other airports can run higher than \$650.

- How it works, a few weeks before delivery, I contact Pet Jet Pals and once a flight nanny takes the job, the client sends a \$100 to \$150 deposit to Pet Jet Pals in advance of the flight, then the remaining balance is paid in cash at the airport upon delivery to the flight nanny. I set up everything with Pet Jet Pals.
- One thing about flying standby, the flight nanny does not know if they will actually have a seat on the plane. If there isn't and they can't find another flight that day, I have to pick up the kitten and try another day.
- If they do find a flight and have to land at another airport, they have to do stand by again hoping to find a flight. If they can't, they will either find a hotel or rent a car to drive the rest of way. That would bring your cost up if it got to that point.
